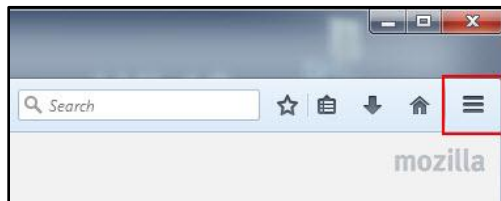


Firefox allows users to set personalized Privacy settings. With some of the available settings selected, browser registration may not be retained by Firefox, causing you to be prompted for a Secure Access Code on every log in. Refer to the options below to have Firefox retain your preferences for DFCU OnLine.

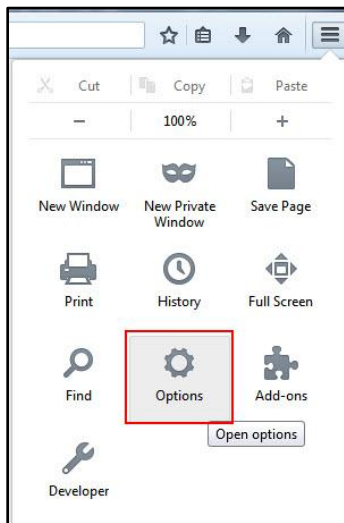
Option 1: Remember History

Follow the steps below to ensure that Firefox will remember the history of your preferences.

In the upper right corner of the window, click on the Tools icon.



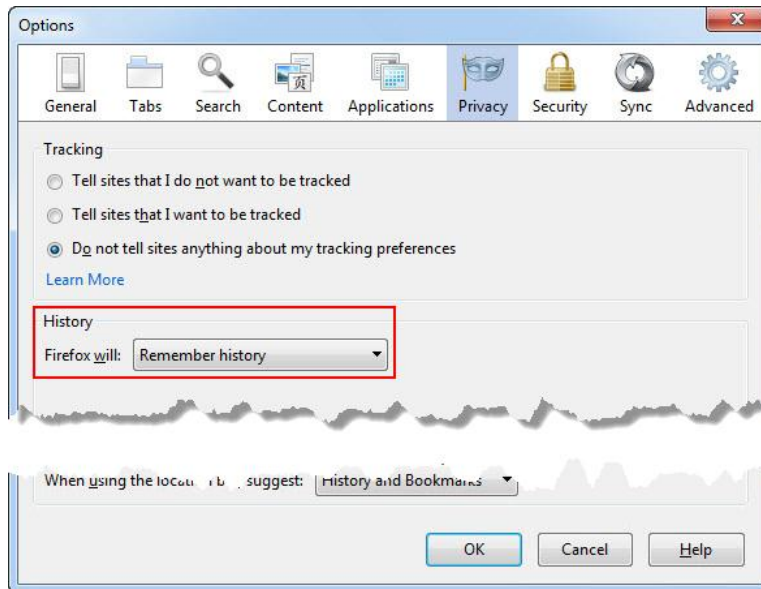
Open the Options menu. Select Options from the Tools menu.



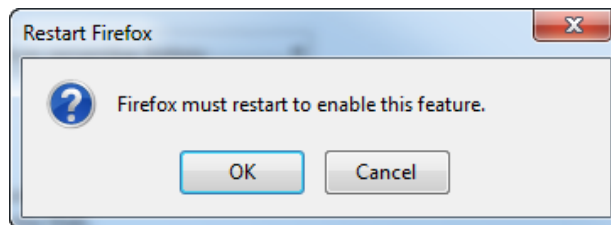
Select the Privacy tab.



Select Remember History from the 'Firefox will' dropdown.

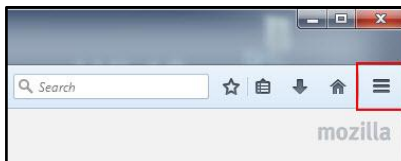


Firefox may need to restart for this feature to be enabled.

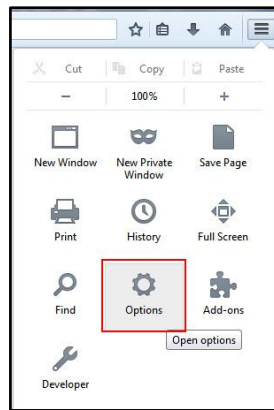


Option 2: Change the custom settings for history

In the upper right corner of the window, click on the Tools icon.



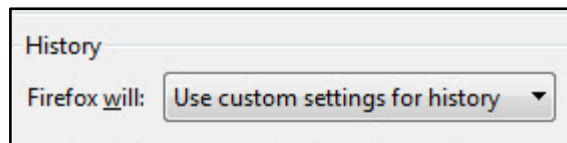
Open the Options menu. Select Options from the Tools menu.



Select the Privacy tab.



If the 'Use custom settings for history' option is selected in the 'Firefox will' dropdown, ensure Cookies are not deleted when Firefox is closed.



To view the Settings for Clearing History, click on Settings. Uncheck Cookies and click OK.

 **Note:** Settings is only available when the 'Always use private browsing mode' is **NOT** checked.
