and jumping into big piles of leaves!



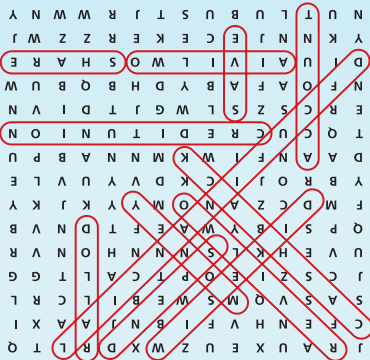

MAKE YOUR OWN FALL LEAF SUNCATCHERS

YOU WILL NEED:

- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Transparent contact paper
- Leaves from your backyard
- Markers
- Hole punch
- Yarn
- Glue
- Glitter and stickers optional

HERE'S HOW:

- 1** Gather your supplies.
- 2** Trace (2) 5x7 inch circles on the contact paper. Cut out the circles from the contact paper. Peel the backing off one piece and place on your work surface with the sticky side up.
- 3** Place leaves onto sticky contact paper.
- 4** Peel the backing off the other sheet of contact paper and place the sticky side down onto the sheet you decorated with leaves. This will create a sandwich sealing the design together.
- 5** Cut a circle out of the center of the paper plate. (Circle should be smaller than the "leaf" circle)
- 6** Glue the contact paper to the paper plate hole that you cut.
- 7** Hole punch the top of the paper plate and insert a loop of yarn.
- 8** Decorate with additional glitter or stickers.
- 9** Hang in a window of your house and enjoy!

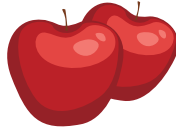
FUN FALL ACTIVITIES WITHOUT BREAKING THE BANK:
